ADDITION AND VARIATION

Dear Sir

I refer to your request dated 30 October 2007 for addition and variation to APMA-E2000-004 Revision 1.

In accordance with the provisions of CASR (1998) 21.303 CASA has found that the design/process data as submitted by Microair Avionics Pty Ltd (hereafter referred to as "the Manufacturer") meets the airworthiness requirements of the Civil Aviation Regulations applicable to the products on which the parts are to be installed.

Additionally, CASA has determined that the Manufacturer has an established fabrication inspection system required by CASR (1998) 21.303(11), and accordingly, approval is hereby granted, pursuant to CASR (1998) 21.303, to the Manufacturer to produce the additional parts listed in the enclosed Supplement Three in conformity with the approved design data.

The design data listed on the Supplement Three enclosed with this letter is to be considered as approved data. This data is not to be altered by the Manufacturer unless permitted or approved by CASA.

The Manufacturer shall produce all parts in accordance with the Manufacturer's Fabrication Inspection System, Microair Avionics Quality Assurance Manual Revision 2-3, dated June 2004 (or later approved revision), and ensure that only conforming parts are released for installation on type certified products.

The conditions, limitations and requirements as outlined in the CASA letter of Australian Parts Manufacturing Approval, dated 14th May 2004, authorising the Manufacturer to manufacture parts at the nominated address, are still in place and are to be read in conjunction with the attached supplement.

This addition and variation is subject to the condition of the existence of a licence agreement between the Holders of STC SVA 513 and Microair Avionics Pty Ltd. CASA must be notified immediately of the termination or variation to the licence agreement.
